- 2. Each entry must be a <u>decorated vehicle or float</u> tying into this year's theme. Float will be judged based on theme and originality. Support your local businesses, sports teams, clubs, schools, and more!
- 3. All entries must complete an online application, pay the entry fee, and be approved by the parade committee prior to participation.
- 4. All entries are restricted to one float or one decorated vehicle.
- 5. No freestyle riding of quads, ATV's or motorcycles allowed.
- 6. All entries must provide their own clean-up including in the parking lot prior to start.
- 7. Due to liability, candy or favors must be handed out by walkers and not thrown from floats. If anything is thrown from a float you will no longer be invited to participate in the Alexandria Fair parade.
- 8. Children must have adult supervision at all times.
